

UNSEEN POETRY ANALYSIS

PEAEAL:

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POINT

- Answer the question in one line. YOUR POINT IS ONLY ONE LINE.

EVIDENCE

- Quote from the poem.
- Advised not to quote a lot (try to keep it to less than 10 words)
- Pick out main ideas + literary devices to unpack

ANALYSIS

- Unpack the more striking words
 - For Example:
"I should not have sat on the fence"
The phrase 'sitting on the fence' shows that the speaker was being indecisive and tried to avoid the decision rather than facing it wholeheartedly. Moreover, the phrase "should not have" shows the speaker's regret in not making a decision.

LINK

- Reinstate your POINT, but add on with a summary of your analysis

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POINT

CONTEXT

- What is happening before the EVIDENCE happens?
- What are the characters' emotions/motives?
- How does this set the mood for the EVIDENCE?

EVIDENCE

- Quote from the play
- Advised not to quote a lot (try to keep it to fewer than 10 words)
- Pick out the main ideas
- Do not use quotes that do not support your POINT

ANALYSIS

- Unpack the more striking words
- Show understanding of the context and overall necessity of the quote

LINK

- Reinstate your POINT, but add on with a summary of your analysis
